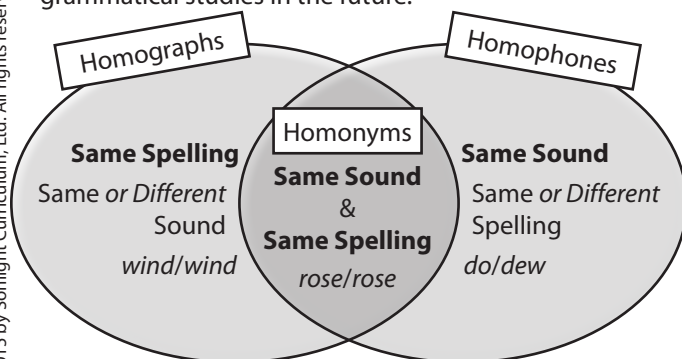

Note: *Phonics Level D* defines homonyms as “words that sound alike but have different meanings and usually different spellings.” We think this definition more accurately describes homophones, since true homonyms are actually spelled identically.
