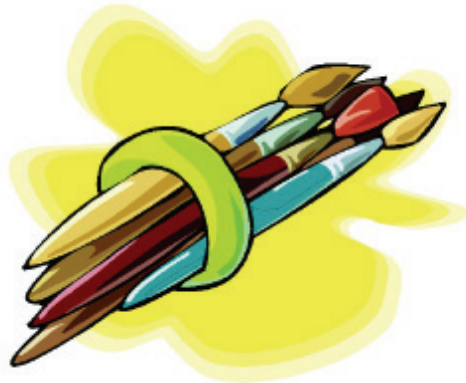


Introduction to the World: Cultures
