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#### How they work

#### **Heart of Dakota**

Charlotte Mason approach "Living books" read purposefully over time Exposure to poetry, music, art, and nature Language arts—narration, copywork, dictation, memorization Christ-centered Multi-level with smaller age increments Programs through 6th grade

#### My Father's World

Biblical worldview Hands-on unit studies, not lit-based Multi-age (focused primarily on grades 2-8)

#### **Tapestry of Grace**

Integrated studies (unit studies) Whole-family learning (same topic, different levels) Cyclical education (4-year chronological study of world history) Detailed lesson plans and discussion outlines

#### How they are different from Sonlight

#### Heart of Dakota

Starts with Bible stories and then American history, rather than world history Short reading assignments, so students can "savor and dwell on the chosen books" Recommended and scheduled resources seem to come more from Christian publishers and/or reprints of old classics, rather than secular sources

Includes suggestions for lots of hands-on activities Instructor's guides are paperback, perfect-bound Weekly schedule page in blocked format

#### My Father's World

Unit study approach, not literature-based Packages do not include Readers and Read-Alouds. Instructor's guides provide library list Includes suggestions for lots of hands-on activities Instructor's guides offer daily schedule but no discussion questions Instructor's guides are smaller, less-detailed and more expensive (1/2 the size for twice the price) Instructor's guides are spiral-bound PreK level comprised of only toys (Lauri toys which can be choking hazard) Return policy—within 30 days in new comdition

#### **Tapestry of Grace**

Strictly chronological, classical education niche All age levels are taught from one **very large** instructor's guide Schedules are weekly, not daily Over 50 pages of notes, schedules, charts, worksheets each week Recommended books must be selected and ordered separately Suggestions for hands-on activities. Lapbook kits available for younger children Instructor's guides are printed in full-color, or available digitally

### **Perceived Strengths**

#### Heart of Dakota

Cheaper (because they schedule fewer books) Hands-on

#### My Father's World

Cheaper (because they schedule fewer books) Hands-on

#### **Tapestry of Grace**

Offers digital IGs-controlled-access pdfs, not adjustable
